

# COMMERCIAL / RECREATION USE OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT CONTROLLED AREA AND ROADS

**EVENT - AUSTRALIA DAY FIREWORKS** 

A permit to conduct an event on local government controlled area, pursuant to the *Local Government Act 2009* and described hereunder is hereby granted to **Xplosive Art Fireworks 12 Jak Gee St Redlynch Qld 4870** subject to the full compliance of the conditions as detailed below, as well as those lawfully imposed by any relevant Governmental, Semi-Governmental or Statutory Authority.

This Permit has been issued only for the following use: Australia Day Fireworks

Approval is granted in accordance with Cassowary Coast Regional Council Local Law No. 1 (Administration) 2011, Subordinate Local Law No. 1 (Administration) 2011, Schedule 24 Undertaking regulated activities on local government controlled areas and roads - c) holding of a public place activity prescribed by subordinate local law and subject to the following conditions:

#### CONDITIONS OF PERMIT:

1. Term of Approval

This Permit is for the term of the event: 26 January 2016

- 2. Term of Renewal of Approval N/A.
- 3. Not Transferable

This permit is not transferable.

4. Hours of Operations

The activity may be operated between 4:30pm and 8:00pm (including set-up and pack-down).

5. Area

The operator, its contractors or agents has approval to conduct the activity on the foreshore and beach area limited to: **Mission Beach** adjacent Marine Parade (refer Map A).

Access to the area

Access to the beach via constructed access point adjacent Mission Beach Caravan Park.

7. Provided Amenities

The following amenities and/or facilities will be available for use by customers:

- Public toilets (where available)
- Formal beach access
- Operational capacity N/A.

#### 9. Equipment

9.1 The approval holder, its contractors or agents must ensure that any motor vehicle, vessels or other machinery used in conjunction with the activity complies with all safety requirements and regulations and are operated in accordance with the requirements, guidelines or recommendations published from time to time by the manufacturer or any State or Commonwealth authority.

#### 10. Safety

The approval holder, its contractors or agents must:

- 10.1 adhere to the safety standards;
- 10.2 provide to its customers or any other persons undertaking the activity all necessary mandatory or appropriate safety equipment, warnings and instruction.
- 10.3 provide information, explanations, cautions and warning to customers and all other persons undertaking the activity regarding the hazards likely to be encountered by them when the activity is undertaken;
- 10.4 only permit experienced suitably qualified and competent guides, agents or supervisors to oversee the operation of the activity.
- 10.5 minimise risks to public safety by strictly operating within the current appropriate Federal and State regulations, rules and guidelines.

#### 11. Indemnification

The approval holder must indemnify the local government against all liability directly or indirectly associated with the activity.

#### 12. Insurance

The approval holder must take out a public liability insurance policy for an amount of not less than with **TWENTY MILLION DOLLARS** (\$20,000,000.00) in the name of the approval holder and the local government.

#### 13. Environmental Protection - natural

The approval holder, its contractors or agents must minimise impacts on the environment from the activity by:

- 13.1 ensuring that vegetation, soil, sand rocks, native animals or natural things are not interfered with, damaged or removed;
- 13.2 ensuring that litter is collected and lawfully disposed at a local government waste transfer station;
- 13.3 limiting all access to the beach via the adjacent designated beach access point and not over fore dune or sensitive areas of the beach profile;
- 13.4 storing equipment within the permit area and not on adjoining road or beach reserves;
- 13.5 maintaining adequate supervision of customers and other persons undertaking the activity;
- 13.6 keeping the permit area in a clean and tidy condition to the satisfaction of the authorised person.

#### 14. Environmental Protection - amenity

The approval holder, its contractors or agents must minimise impacts of the activity on the amenity of the area by:

- 14.1 not using any methods or amplified music/sound which in the opinion of the authorised person constitutes a noise nuisance;
- 14.2 not placing advertising material on the approved area or elsewhere without the prior approval of the Council.

#### 15. Environmental Protection Works

The approval holder must be responsible for any costs or expenses incurred by local government for rectifying any damage caused by the activity.

#### 16. Charges

The approval holder must pay all Local Government and other charges associated with the provision of any facility which may from time to time be required by the Council or any Authority whose consent to the operation of the business of the approval holder may be required.

#### 17. Compliance with:

#### 17.1 Directions

The approval holder, its contractors or agents must comply with all reasonable directions of an authorised person in the time specified by the authorised person.

#### 17.2 Conditions

The approval holder must ensure each condition of this permit is complied with (*Refer Local Law No. 1 (Administration) 2011* Sections 11 and 26. Maximum penalty – 50 penalty units or \$5,500).

#### 17.3 Acts and Regulations

All activities carried out within Local Government controlled road reserves shall comply with any Federal or State legislation or Local Law requirement which may be relevant to the activity.
